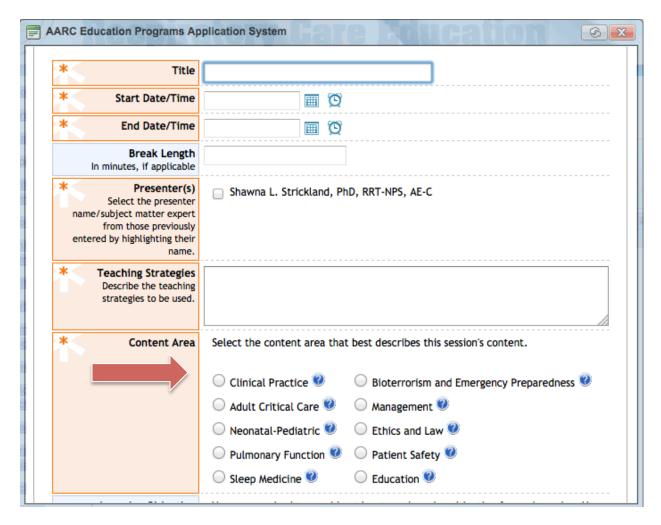
AARC CRCE Content Designation Explanations

When entering the non-traditional application or session information for traditional (live) applications, you will be asked to select a content area. Content areas designate a specific focus of the session in context with the session objectives. The ability to designate content areas for each traditional (live) session or non-traditional course allows the AARC to update the participants' transcripts with the content designator. This is helpful to those therapists who need CRCE® within specific content areas for specialty credentials or for state licensure requirements.



When selecting the content area for each application, please note:

- Only one (1) of the 10 content areas may be chosen for each session in a traditional (live) application. However, each session within a traditional (live) application may have different content areas designated.
- Only one (1) of the 10 content areas may be chosen for the entire non-traditional application, regardless of the number of modules.

The content areas are explained below.
